To keep The Track fun and safe for everyone,
please review our General Rules of Play and
Conduct, Power Cart Policy and Driving
Range Policy below.



General Rules of Play and Conduct

1. All players must register with the Pro Shop staff at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled tee time.
2. No more than 4 players will be permitted in a group unless permission is granted by the Pro Shop staff.
3. The Pro Shop has the right to refuse play to a passholder or guest if they are intoxicated or under the influence of drugs.
4. No outside alcohol is permitted on the premise as per Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis Regulations. Any player found in violation will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
5. Music on the golf course is permitted. The level of music should be audible for your group only.
6. The property line of the golf course is defined by roads and fence lines. Please respect the residents of Boulder Creek Estates and do not enter their yards and or interfere with their privacy.
7. Errant golf shots that result in damage to homes on Boulder Creek Estates must be reported to the Pro Shop as soon as possible. It is the responsibility of the golfer who struck the golf shot to pay for any damage caused by errant shots. The 2023 Golf Canada Membership provides insurance coverage for broken windows, lost or stolen golf equipment and damage to power carts.
8. The health and safety of the staff at The Track is our priority. Abusive, threatening or harassing behaviour (physical, emotional, sexual) is strictly prohibited and will be dealt with immediately. The offending party will be asked to leave the premises immediately and in extreme cases the RCMP will be called if necessary.
9. Cancellation of tee times: Life gets busy and we understand. Out of respect for your fellow golfers and passholders, we ask that you call the Pro Shop at the earliest possible time to cancel your spot or group, allowing someone else to play. An updated cancellation policy will be released ahead of the 2023 golf season.

For the benefit of all, the Pro Shop and golf course staff will strictly enforce these rules and have the right to refuse golfing privileges to anyone who chooses to not follow the General Rules of Play and Conduct.

Power Cart Policy

1. Only two riders and two golf bags are allowed on one cart at any time.
2. Operators of a power cart must be a minimum of 16 years of age and/or possess a registered Provincial Driver's License.
3. All power cart rentals will require the consent and signing of a Rental Agreement contract. Any damage, to the body, mechanical, or interior, whether accidental or purposeful will be the full responsibility of the individual signing the agreement.
4. Emergency brake must be engaged when parking the power cart at all times.
5. Keep both feet and arms in the power cart at all times when the cart is moving.
6. Power carts should remain on cart paths around all putting greens and tee boxes.
7. The Pro Shop staff and/or Course Starter will advise the rules and restrictions for that day's play.
8. Golf course staff has the ability to ask golfers to leave the premise immediately under any of the following situations:
 - a. Appear to be intoxicated or under the influence of drugs
 - b. Operating the power cart in a manner that is dangerous to the driver, the passenger, other golfers and/or property.
 - c. Repeatedly not following the daily rules and restrictions for the golf course as described by the Pro Shop staff or Course Starter.

For the benefit of all, the Pro Shop and golf course staff will strictly enforce these rules and have the right to refuse golfing privileges to anyone who chooses to not follow the General Rules of Play and Conduct.

Driving Range Policy

1. The driving range is there for the enjoyment of all golfers. Please be respectful of language, music and behaviour at all times on the range.
 2. A Driving Range Pass (Season) is intended to be used by the individual/couple or family that is named on the pass. The pass is not transferable.
 3. A Junior Driving Range Season pass will permit them to two (2) large baskets per day.
 4. Range balls, range passes (Season) will be revoked if a golfer is caught purposefully aiming for the boundaries (farm field to south or cart storage facility to the north).
 5. Please stay within the tee markers as indicated on the grass tee or on the turf mats if they are in use.
 6. Driving range hours will be determined by the Pro Shop and posted. There will be specific times when the range will be closed for maintenance and or special events to the public and range pass holders.
